BACKGROUND

CPLR§3015(e) requires where the plaintiff's cause of action against a consumer arises from the plaintiff's conduct of a business which is required by state or local law to be licensed by the Department of Consumer Affairs of the City of New York the complaint shall allege, as part of the cause of action, that plaintiff is duly licensed and shall contain the name and number, if any, of such license and the governmental agency which issued such license.

DIRECTIVE

The clerk shall not enter a failure to answer judgment on a Consumer Credit Transaction filed after January 1st of 2008, unless the complaint complies with CPLR§3015(e).
