SYMPOSIUM ON ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE**

On Tuesday, November 14, 2023, Presiding Justice Hector D. LaSalle and the Associate Justices of the Appellate Division, Second Department, presented a Symposium entitled **“Contemplating the Future of Artificial Intelligence and the Appellate Division, Second Department.”** The speakers were **Dorothy R. Auth, Esq.**, Partner and Head of Intellectual Property Practice at Cadwalader, Wickersham & Taft LLP; **Professor Benjamin L. Liebman**, the Robert L. Lieff Professor of Law and Director of the Hong Yen Chang Center for Chinese Legal Studies at Columbia Law School; **Luca Melchionna, Esq.**, Principal of Melchionna PLLC, Chair of the Technology and Venture Law Committee of the Business Law Section of the New York State Bar Association, and Counsel for Legal Affairs, European Public Law Organization; and **Matthew Stepka, Esq.**, Managing Partner of Machina Ventures, and Lecturer, UC Berkeley, Haas School of Business.

Associate Justices Angela G. Iannacci and Deborah A. Dowling co-chaired the Symposium.

The Symposium drew attendees from each of the ten Counties comprising the Second Department’s jurisdiction; many of them interacted with the speakers with challenging questions.
