AD1 2.0: Appellate Division, First Department Holds First-Ever Virtual Oral Arguments

On Wednesday, May 6, 2020, the Appellate Division, First Department held its firstever virtual oral arguments, via a Skype meeting that was livestreamed over the internet. Hon. David Friedman, the Justice Presiding over the hearings, noted in his opening remarks that "This is the first virtual session of the Appellate Division, First Department with oral argument.
