MOTION/CASE IS RESPECTFULLY REFERRED TO JUSTICE FOR THE FOLLOWING REASON(S):

Plaintiff by letter dated January 13, 2006 has requested that this case be transferred to the Commercial Division. Counsel states that the assigned Justice has approved the request. Pursuant to the Guidelines for Assignment of Cases to the Commercial Division that were in effect at the time the request was submitted (uniform statewide standards and rules went into effect on January 17, 2006), counsel was required to direct such an application to the assigned Justice, but a transfer required the approval of the Administrative Judge. I decline to approve this request. A Request for Judicial Intervention was filed in this case in April 2001. All applications for assignment to the Commercial Division should be made promptly after a case is assigned so that the matter proceeds in the proper Part throughout its life. Subsequent changes in judicial assignment do not provide a basis for untimely transfers to the Commercial Division.
