

CHANGE OF ADDRESS

1. If you have changed your address after you have made application to the State Board of Law Examiners for admission to the bar examination (or for certification of your legal education for admission on motion without examination) and prior to your certification by the State Board of Law Examiners to an Appellate Division Department, you should promptly notify the [State Board of Law Examiners](#) and advise them of such change online.
2. If you change your address after the certification by the State Board of Law Examiners but before you are admitted, you should promptly notify the appropriate Appellate Division Department of such change by letter or email. The change of address should be sent to the filing office of the Appellate Division to which you are certified and/or where your application is filed.
