**NOTICE TO ATTORNEYS LISTED IN ATTACHED DECISION
DATED SEPTEMBER 24, 2009**

Attached is a copy of this Court's Memorandum and Order dated September 24, 2009, which suspends you from practice in the State of New York, effective 30 days from the date of the decision, by reason of your failure to register as an attorney with the Office of Court Administration (OCA) and pay the registration fees as required by section 468-a of the Judiciary Law.

If you wish to continue as an attorney in New York, you should immediately contact OCA's Attorney Registration Unit at 212-428-2800 which will advise you of the amount of the registration fees due and owing and also provide you with the necessary registration form which you must complete and return to that office along with your payment.

After you file your registration form with OCA and pay the required fees, you must then send this office proof of your compliance (e.g. a copy of your completed registration form together with a copy of your check or temporary receipt) along with a request to have your name removed from the suspension list. If your request is made after the effective date of the suspension order, it must be accompanied by an affidavit setting forth an explanation for your failure to maintain your registration, whether you have ever been the subject of public or private professional discipline in any jurisdiction, and whether, since the effective date of the suspension order, you practiced law or held yourself out as being able to practice law in the State of New York. A copy of your communication to this office must be sent to the Committee on Professional Standards, Third Judicial Department, 40 Steuben Street, Suite 502, Albany, New York, 12207. Following receipt of your request and the required proof, the Court may direct that your name be removed from the suspension list or order that you be reinstated to practice.

Finally, you should be advised that on and after the effective date of the Court's suspension order, you are not permitted to appear as an attorney or practice law in New York until you have fully complied with the registration requirements of the Judiciary Law by filing the necessary registration form and paying the required fees, and have been reinstated to practice by order of the Court.
