*** Requesting Copies of Briefs and Records or other Case Documents ***

Public access to briefs, records and other case-related documents is generally governed by Judiciary Law § 255. Certain matters are sealed by statute or court policy and are not accessible to the public.

As most matters pending before the Court are E-Filed through NYSCEF, cases that are not sealed in NYSCEF can be accessed by the public by searching <u>NYSCEF</u>. For access to court filings that are not accessible through NYSCEF, you may make a document request by emailing the Court's Clerk's office at <u>ad3clerksoffice@nycourts.gov</u>. Criminal matters are not accessible in NYSCEF, although the filings not otherwise marked confidential may be accessible to the public by emailing the Clerk's Office.
