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

SUBJECT: Mandatory Surcharges - Chapter 57, Laws of 2000

Attached is an amended Part IV / Chapter 3.120 of the Financial Planning & Control Manual which reflects the provisions of Chapter 57 of the Laws of 2000. This chapter amends section 60.35 of the Penal Law and section 1809 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law relative to the amount of the mandatory surcharge and crime victims assistance fee to be imposed upon persons convicted of a criminal offense or an offense under the Vehicle and Traffic Law. These rate provisions are effective April 1, 2000.

Chapter 3.120 revisions also reflects the provisions of Chapter 497 of the Laws of 1999 which established a new \$30.00 penalty upon conviction for any statute, state or local law, ordinance or rule relating to handicapped parking. The proceeds of this new penalty are earmarked to support local handicapped parking enforcement programs. This new penalty is also effective April 1, 2000.
