The 2014 Women's History Month keynote presentation will be made by **Mary Solomon**, Director of the Scan Van program for Project Renewal. Project Renewal is a non profit organization which aims to end the cycle of homelessness by empowering men and women with mental illness, addiction or both, to renew their lives with health, homes and jobs. The Scan Van program travels throughout New York, and provides free breast cancer screening exams to uninsured and low income women. Previously, Mary was the Executive Director of Women's Outreach Network, a mobile mammography program which also targeted the underserved, and was the Founder and Executive Director of Outreach for Breast Health Foundation, a non profit organization dedicated to educating and providing access for under-served women to breast health care. She is a past member of the Breast Cancer Steering Committees for both Nassau County and Suffolk County.

The Gender Fairness Committee will also be proudly awarding the 2014 Distinguished Service Award to **Linell Hunter, Esq.** Linell presently serves as the Deputy Chief Court Attorney of the Law Department, New York County, Civil Term.
