Roberta A. Kaplan, Esq., graduated from Harvard University in 1988, magna cum laude, Phi Beta Kappa, and received her Juris Doctorate from Columbia Law School in 1991. She has served as a Senior Law Clerk to Chief Judge Judith S. Kaye of the New York Court of Appeals and also clerked for the Honorable Mark L. Wolf of the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts.

Ms. Kaplan presently serves as a partner in the Litigation Department of Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton & Garrison LLP, and her legal work has earned her national recognition including being chosen by The National Law Journal as one of the top "40 under 40" lawyers in the United States, as a New York "Super Lawyer," and as one of the 500 leading litigators in the United States. In February of 2013, Ms. Kaplan was named by Chief Judge Jonathan Lippman to serve on the Commercial Division Advisory Council.

Along with her extensive experience representing major corporate clients in complex, high profile matters, Ms. Kaplan's pro bono work has also been nationally recognized. Most recently, Ms. Kaplan argued in front of the Supreme Court of the United States on behalf of her client Edith Windsor in a case which challenges the constitutionality of the Defense of Marriage Act.
