VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Uncontested Divorce: Help clients secure uncontested divorces. No court appearance before a matrimonial judge is required (papers are submitted).

Can Volunteers Work Off Site: Yes.

Type of Work: Full Representation; Legal Research & Writing.

Location, Days and Hours of Volunteer Opportunity:
Volunteer works from their own home or office or may meet with clients at the QVLP office.

Area of Substantive Law: Matrimonial.

Supervision: QVLP provides plenty of mentoring for its volunteers. They have a mentoring panel, which takes phone calls from volunteers. Plus, Mr. Weliky is always willing to talk with a volunteer.

Training: QVLP requires that all volunteers undergo at least some training unless the volunteer has substantial experience in that area of law. It provides free seminars for volunteers on various topics. They also have written materials, videos/DVDs of trainings which volunteers can watch, and sometimes it offers courses for CLE credit.
