Capacity: PBP has the capacity to host a large number of volunteers.

Experience: Previous experience in area of substantive law is recommended.

Supervision and assistance: PBP has several lawyers on its staff that work closely with its volunteers on pro bono matters (PBP staff attorneys also directly handle about 20% of PBP projects). On appropriate matters, PBP can also match attorneys with practicing attorneys to provide additional guidance. PBP staff also regularly checks in with volunteers on the status of a matter.

PBP has many forms, model documents and other resources for use by its volunteer attorneys.
