Worker Justice Center of New York (WJC), which represents the joining together of Farmworker Legal Services of NY and the Workers' Rights Law Center of NY, has been serving migrant and seasonal farm workers for the past 30 years through direct representation in civil matters regarding employment and wage issues. WJC also serves the migrant community who may be victims of human trafficking, domestic violence, and exposure to pesticides.
