DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:

Court Attorney-Referees act as special referees and research and analyze complex legal issues and questions raised in civil and criminal cases heard in trial courts or on appeal to certain County Courts and may be responsible for supervision of court attorneys and support staff who are located in one or more courts situated throughout a county, judicial district, or department. They serve in a confidential capacity and work with substantial independence from supervision in units located in the Court of Claims or special parts in the Supreme Court or in County, District, Family, and Surrogate's Courts in counties entirely within cities or in counties that have populations exceeding 400,000.

ASSIGNMENT: This position will be assigned to the District Administrative Judge's Office and duties will include but are not limited to: reviewing legal documents, researching and analyzing complex substantive and procedural issues, and drafting confidential memoranda and proposed orders, including administrative orders. Additional duties include managing county-wide projects assigned by the District Administrative Judge or designee including those related to Access to Justice, serving as Special Counsel to the Town and Village Courts as well as Public Information Officer for the Suffolk County Courts, acting as liaison to Suffolk County and other municipalities, law enforcement agencies, as well as the Suffolk County Criminal Justice Coordinating Counsel and bar associations.
