Administrative Judge Announces Dedication of the Sixth District Court

CENTRAL ISLIP, NY – Suffolk County’s District Administrative Judge, H. Patrick Leis III and the Supervising Judge of the District Court, Madeleine A. Fitzgibbon are pleased to announce the formal dedication of the Suffolk County Sixth District Court at a special ceremony to be held on November 17, 2004 at 10:30 a.m., at the Sixth District Court.

The Sixth District Court, which is located at 150 West Main Street, Patchogue, New York, has undergone extensive renovations over the past year as part of the continuing commitment of Suffolk County and the New York State Court System to quality service.

The renovated courthouse contains an enlarged courtroom to accommodate jury trials, a jury deliberation room, attorney-client rooms, two arbitration hearing rooms and enhanced security technology. In addition, there is a new spacious lobby for court patrons which has been designed to include a modern public information system which will provide procedural information to self represented litigants and attorneys who are navigating through the court system.

According to Justice Leis, “The renovations go well beyond cosmetic upgrades. The state of the art improvements are substantial and will allow court patrons seeking judicial relief to do so in comfortable and dignified surroundings befitting our justice system.”
