What is U-CAN? U-CAN is a novel, court-monitored mentoring program targeting 18-25 year-old criminal defendants who:
(1) are charged with a misdemeanor; and
(2) fall within the following general pattern:
their parents are absent or uninterested; they are lacking structure, guidance and support; they are angry, directionless and feeling increasingly worthless; if they are in school, they likely are failing; their anti-social behavior is increasing in seriousness and edging closer to felonious conduct and violence. They have not yet given up on their life but are perilously close, are at a critical crossroad and desperately in need of a positive role model. Without intervention, it is probable that these individuals will commit a serious crime and victimize innocent people.
