
Administrative Order:

By letter dated May 11, 2016, defendants' counsel requests that this action be transferred into the Commercial Division pursuant to the Rules of the Commercial Division, Uniform Rule 202.70 (e). To date, no opposition has been received.

Actions in which the principal claims are for breach of contract or business torts, where the breach or violation is alleged to arise out of business dealings, may be heard in the Commercial Division, provided the \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County is met or equitable or declaratory is sought (Uniform Rule 202.70 [a], [b] [1]). The complaint in this action seeks injunctive and declaratory relief in regard to defendants' alleged breach of an Option Agreement entered into by the parties, or, in the alternative, monetary damages of \$9.2 million for this breach.

Accordingly, the request for a transfer to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's Office is directed to randomly reassign this case to a Justice of the Commercial Division. (There is motion to dismiss currently returnable on June 13, 2016 in the E-Filed Submissions Part.)
