By letter dated August 15, 2008, respondent's counsel requests that this action be transferred into the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. There is no objection to this timely request.

The petitioner seeks an attachment in aid of arbitration pursuant to CPLR 7502(c) in connection with his claims for breach of an employment agreement and the recovery of over \$750,000 in unpaid salary and severance benefits.
