The Independent Judicial Election Qualification Commissions (IJEQC) for the Second, Ninth, Tenth, Eleventh and Thirteenth Judicial Districts of the Second Judicial Department (see attached 2012 Vacancy List), is accepting Questionnaires for judicial candidates who wish to have their qualifications reviewed for public election to the Supreme Court, County Court, Surrogate's Court, Family Court, New York City Civil Court, District Courts and City Courts. The voluntary statewide screening process for evaluating judicial candidates was established in 2007 by the New York State Unified Court System.
