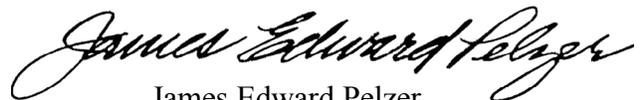
Appeal by the defendant from a judgment of the Supreme Court, Kings County (Guzman, J.), rendered November 28, 2005, convicting him of attempted criminal possession of a weapon in the third degree, upon his plea of guilty, and imposing sentence.

ORDERED that the judgment is affirmed.

The defendant voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waived his right to appeal (*see People v Ramos*, 7 NY3d 737; *People v Lopez*, 6 NY3d 248; *People v Seaberg*, 74 NY2d 1, 11). The defendant's valid waiver of his right to appeal forecloses appellate review of his challenge to the Supreme Court's suppression determination (*see People v Kemp*, 94 NY2d 831, 833; *People v Munford*, 37 AD3d 855; *People v Smith*, 35 AD3d 769; *People v Peoples*, 34 AD3d 503, *lv denied* 8 NY3d 833; *People v Campbell*, 24 AD3d 463).
