Services, to arrange for the petitioner's attendance at a hearing before the Westchester County
Department of Social Services regarding the petitioner's request that certain records regarding
alleged abuse be expunged, and application by the petitioner for poor person relief.


ORDERED that the application for poor person relief is granted to the extent that

further,

ADJUDGED that the proceeding is dismissed, without costs or disbursements.
