
Appeal by the defendant from a judgment of the County Court, Dutchess County  
(Hayes, J.), rendered March 10, 2009, convicting him of attempted criminal possession of a controlled  
substance in the fourth degree, upon his plea of guilty, and imposing sentence.

ORDERED that the judgment is affirmed.

We have reviewed the record and agree with the defendant's assigned counsel that  
there are no nonfrivolous issues which could be raised on appeal. Counsel's application for leave to
