Appeals by the defendant from two judgments of the County Court, Suffolk County (Hudson, J.), both rendered September 8, 2009, convicting him of assault in the second degree and resisting arrest under Indictment No. 2180/08 and robbery in the first degree under Indictment No. 3088/08, upon his pleas of guilty, and imposing sentences. Assigned counsel has submitted a brief in accordance with *Anders v California* (386 US 738), in which he moves for leave to withdraw as counsel for the appellant.

ORDERED that the judgments are affirmed.

We have reviewed the record and agree with the defendant's assigned counsel that there are no nonfrivolous issues which could be raised on these appeals. Counsel's application for
