MOTION FOR REINSTATEMENT

In the Matter of Hector M. Roman, Jr., admitted as
Hector Manuel Roman, Jr., a suspended attorney.

Motion by Hector M. Roman, Jr., for reinstatement to the Bar as an attorney and counselor-at-law. Mr. Roman was admitted to the New York State Bar at a term of the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court in the Second Judicial Department on May 17, 1995, under the name Hector Manuel Roman, Jr. By opinion and order of this Court dated December 26, 2007, Mr. Roman was publicly censured based on the disciplinary action taken against him by the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit (*see Matter of Roman*, 48 AD3d 25). By opinion and order of this Court dated March 22, 2011, Mr. Roman was suspended from the practice of law for six months, commencing April 22, 2011, based on disciplinary action taken against him by the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit (*see Matter of Roman*, 83 AD3d 40).
