Appeal by the defendant from an amended judgment of the Supreme Court, Kings County (DiMango, J.), rendered May 11, 2009, revoking a sentence of probation previously imposed by the same court (Ingram, J.), upon a finding that he violated a condition thereof, upon his admission, and imposing a sentence of imprisonment upon his previous conviction of attempted robbery in the third degree. Assigned counsel has submitted a brief in accordance with *Anders v California* (386 US 738), in which she moves to be relieved of the assignment to prosecute the appeal.

ORDERED that the amended judgment is affirmed.

We are satisfied with the sufficiency of defense counsel's brief filed pursuant to *Anders v California* (386 US 738) and, upon an independent review of the record, we conclude that there are no nonfrivolous issues which could be raised on appeal. Counsel's application for leave
