Proceeding pursuant to CPLR article 78 to compel the respondent William P. Warren,
a Judge of the Family Court, Rockland County, inter alia, to allow the petitioner access to her
juvenile delinquency court files, and application for poor person relief.

filing fee imposed by CPLR 8022(b) is waived, and the application is otherwise denied as academic;
and it is further,

ADJUDGED that the proceeding is dismissed, without costs or disbursements.
