The CUNY School of Law is located at 2 Court Square in the Long Island City section of Queens, New York just minutes from Manhattan across the East River. It is housed in the curved, 14-story glass building at the corner of 44th Drive and Hunter Street.

Traveling by Public Transportation from

Manhattan and Queens,

take the E or M train to Court Square-23rd Street (first stop in Queens)

take the 7 train to Court Square

take the N or Q train to Queensboro Plaza, where you can change for the 7 train, which you will take one stop to Court Square

Brooklyn,

take the G train to Court Square

take the 2, 3, 4, or 5 train to 42nd Street in Manhattan and transfer there to the 7 train to Court Square

take the A, B, C, D or F train to West 4th Street, where you can transfer for the Queens-bound E or M train to Court Square-23rd Street

the Bronx,

take the B or D train to 7th Avenue and transfer for the Queens-bound E train to Court Square-23rd Street

take the 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 train to 42nd Street in Manhattan and transfer to the 7 train to Court Square.

By Subway

2, 3, 4, 5 to Borough Hall Station. M, R to Court Street Station. A, C, F to Jay Street-Borough Hall Station.

By Bus

From Port Authority Bus Terminal, take the A, C subway to Jay Street-Borough Hall Station.

By Railroad

MetroNorth: From Grand Central Terminal, take the 4 or 5 subway lines to Borough Hall Station.

Amtrak: From Pennsylvania Station, take the A or C subway lines to Jay Street-Borough Hall Station or take the 2 or 3 subway lines to Borough Hall Station.

LIRR (Long Island Railroad): Take train to Brooklyn Station, and then take either the 2, 3, 4 or 5 subway lines to Borough Hall Station.
