**Administrative Order:**

By letter dated July 23, 2018, plaintiffs' counsel timely requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Commercial Division Rule 202.70 (e). No response to the request has been received.

This is an action for breach of a contract to provide on-line fraud screening of "card-not-present" credit card transactions. The complaint seeks \$930,000 in damages. The request is granted, since the allegations of the complaint meet the monetary threshold and fall within the subject matter of cases heard in the Commercial Division (see Commercial Division Rule 202.70 [a], [b] [1]).

The General Clerk's Office is directed to transfer this action to a Justice of the Commercial Division. This transfer is without prejudice to the right of the newly-assigned Commercial Division Justice to transfer the case out of the Commercial Division if, in his or her discretion, the action does not truly meet the \$500,000 monetary threshold for New York County's Commercial Division. (A motion to dismiss the complaint is currently returnable in the E-Filed Submissions Part on August 10, 2018.)
