By letter dated August 3, 2017, counsel for defendant Jeryl Hofmann timely requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Commercial Division Rule 202.70 (e). No opposition to the request has been received.

The complaint in this action by a former employer against two former employees alleges claims of misappropriation of trade secrets, breach of fiduciary duty, tortious interference with prospective economic advantage, tortious interference with contract, unfair competition, and unjust enrichment. Monetary damages and injunctive relief are sought. This action qualifies for assignment to the Commercial Division pursuant to Commercial Division Rule 202.70 (a) and (b) (1).

The request is granted. The General Clerk's Office is directed to assign this case at random to a Justice of the Commercial Division. Counsel for the parties are directed to contact the part clerk of the newly-assigned Commercial Division Justice to reschedule the pending order to show cause for a preliminary injunction, presently returnable on September 7, 2017 in I.A.S. Part 47 (Edwards, J.)
