TORT - PERSONAL INJURY; COMPARATIVE NEGLIGENCE - SUFFICIENCY OF EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT JURY VERDICT;

Supreme Court, New York County, inter alia, entered judgment in favor of plaintiffs, apportioning liability and finding plaintiff 15% liable; App. Div., insofar as relevant, affirmed.
