To do so you must notify the Clerk of this Family Court of your wish to appeal. The Clerk then will file and serve the appropriate notice of appeal.

If you are not represented by an attorney, you have a right to request the Appellate Division indicated above to appoint an attorney to represent you for the purpose of filing an appeal.

You will be required to obtain and pay for a transcript of the above proceeding.

If you are unable to pay for this transcript or any other costs of this appeal, you may apply for leave to appeal as a poor person. This application must be made in the Appellate Division indicated above and the Clerk of that Court will assist you in making this application.
