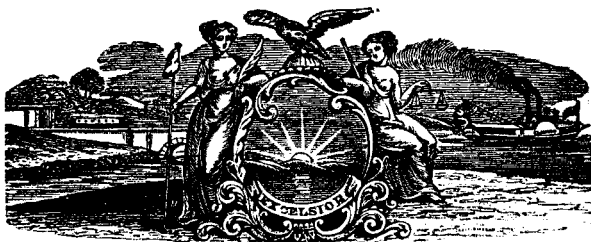

CHAP. 247.

AN ACT *to amend the Revised Statutes in relation to persons held in slavery.*

[Passed May 25, 1841.]

The People of the State of New-York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows :

§ 1. The third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh sections of **Repeal.** title seven, Chapter twenty of the first Part of the Revised Statutes are hereby repealed.
