

Honorable Alan D. Scheinkman was elected a Justice of the Supreme Court, Ninth Judicial District in November, 2005 where he sits on the Commercial Division. Justice Scheinkman also serves as an Associate Justice of the Appellate Term for the Ninth and Tenth Judicial Districts. He is a member of the Committee on Pattern Jury Instructions - Civil of the Supreme Court Justices Association. He is also a member of the Chief Judge's Commission on Intergovernmental Relations. Justice Scheinkman began his legal career as law clerk to Hon. Mathew J. Jasen, Senior Associate Judge of the New York Court of Appeals. He is the author of a two-volume treatise on Domestic Relations Law and the directing editor of 12 volumes of text and forms FOR MCKINNEY'S. He served as Executive Director of the New York State Bar Association Task Force on Administrative Adjudication and is a member of the Association's Committee on Appellate Courts. He is a coauthor, with Professor David D. Siegel, of both the Second Edition of the New York State Bar Association's Practitioner's Handbook on Practice in the Appellate Divisions and the Third Edition of the Association's Handbook on Practice in the New York Court of Appeals. He continues to teach as an Adjunct Professor of Law at St. John's University School of Law and he has also taught at Pace University School of Law and at Rutgers University School of Law, Newark. Justice Scheinkman is a graduate of George Washington University and St. John's University School of Law. In law school he was a Notes and Comments Editor of the Law Review and a research assistant to Professor David D. Siegel.
