

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE OF THE COURTS**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me, and upon consultation with the Administrative Board of the Courts, and with the approval of the Court of Appeals, I hereby amend, effective immediately, section 100.5(A)(4)(f) of the Chief Administrator's Rules Governing Judicial Conduct, relating to the judicial candidate ethics education program, to read as follows:

(A) Incumbent Judges and Others Running for Public Election to Judicial Office.

* * *

(4) A judge or a non-judge who is a candidate for public election to judicial office:

* * *

(f) shall complete an education program, either in person or by videotape or by internet correspondence course, developed or approved by the Chief Administrator or his or her designee within any time after the candidate makes a public announcement of candidacy or authorizes solicitation or acceptance of contributions for a known judicial vacancy, but no later than 30 days after receiving the nomination ~~or 90 days prior to receiving the nomination~~ for judicial office. The date of nomination for candidates running in a primary election shall be the date upon which the candidate files a designating petition with the Board of Elections. This provision shall apply to all candidates for elective judicial office in the Unified Court System

except for town and village justices.
