CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 15
(Submitted but Never Entered)
**Pre-Trial Discovery
and Scheduling Order
Governing Certain Cases**

It is on this _____ day of _____, 2003, ORDERED that:

1. Designations of all party and non-party fact witnesses in the following cases shall be completed on or before **June 16, 2003**: 1) *Abriel, Linda and Theodore v. Allegiance Corporation, et al.*, Case No. 8513/00; 2) *Cordova, Felix v. Emerald Medical Supplies, et al.*, Case No. 18584/97; 3) *Mabry, Lillie v. Allegiance Corporation, et al.*, Case No. 103251/00; 4) *Charlotte Sinrod v. Ansell Perry, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 97/118434 and 5) *Winchester, Kimberly v. Allegiance Corporation, et al.*, Case No. 8753/00. These cases are collectively referred to as the "Trial Track Cases" herein.
2. Depositions of all party and non-party fact witnesses in the Trial Track Cases shall be completed on or before **July 11, 2003**.
3. Plaintiffs in each Trial Track case shall designate each of their expert witnesses no later than **June 27, 2003**, by serving upon each defendant in the case, by facsimile or by

personal service, an expert's report and expert material for each expert in the case. At the time plaintiffs' designate their experts, they shall provide to defendants two dates on which each of plaintiffs' experts is available for deposition.

4. On or before **July 17, 2003**, plaintiffs in the Trial Track Cases shall make available and present their designated expert witnesses for depositions.
5. All Independent Medical Exams of the plaintiffs in the Trial Track Cases are to be completed on or before **July 25, 2003**.
6. Defendants in each Trial Track Case shall designate each of their expert witnesses no later than **August 1, 2003**, by serving upon each defendant in the case, by facsimile or by personal service, an expert's report and expert material for each expert in the case. At the time defendants' designate their experts, they shall provide to plaintiffs two dates on which of defendants' expert is available for deposition.
7. On or before **August 15, 2003**, defendants in the Trial Track Cases shall make available and present their designated expert witnesses for depositions.
8. Any party in the Trial Track Cases may serve Requests for Admissions no later than **August 11, 2003**.
9. All dispositive motions in the Trial Track Cases shall be filed and served no later than **July 29, 2003**.
10. On **August 18, 2003**, plaintiffs shall serve and file Note of Issue in each of the Trial Track Cases.
11. *Charlotte Sinrod v. Ansell Perry, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 97/118434, will proceed to trial

first, beginning on **September 2, 2003**.

12. On **August 15, 2003** the Court shall set trial dates in the remaining Trial Track Cases.
13. Mediation of any Trial Track Case shall occur at any time either by agreement of the parties or by further order of the Court.
14. This Order shall be entered separately and shall govern and control activity in each Trial Track Case.
