ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 178

It appearing that Reliance Insurance Company ("Reliance"), a Pennsylvania corporation, has been placed into liquidation by order of a court of the State of Pennsylvania, and the Superintendent of Insurance of the State of New York having been appointed, by order of the Supreme Court, New York County, Ancillary Receiver of Reliance in the State of New York, and

It further appearing that applications for leave to be relieved as counsel may be submitted by attorneys appearing in litigation in which the claim is covered by the New York Public Motor Vehicle Liability Security Fund as to a party or parties who is/are insured through a policy issued by Reliance (said litigation being hereinafter referred to as "Reliance PMV cases"),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Deputy Chief Administrative Judge of the State of New York for the New York City Courts, that attorneys who seek to be relieved as counsel in Reliance PMV cases that are pending in the Supreme Court in any county within the City of New York or in the Civil Court of the City of New York shall move in the Supreme Court, New York County by a single omnibus motion for such relief with respect to and in multiple cases in which the moving attorney appears irrespective of the county within the City of New York in which the cases are pending, and it is further

ORDERED that all such motions shall be assigned to Honorable Jacqueline W. Silbermann, Administrative Judge of the Supreme Court, Civil Branch, New York County, for the purpose of ruling on the aforesaid applications, including determination of the appropriate method of service of the motion papers and, in the event that such an application is granted and if deemed appropriate, issuance of a stay of further proceedings in the affected action(s) to provide time for the retention of new counsel, and it is further


ORDERED that the applicant shall submit any such motion under the omnibus caption hereinabove set forth and shall annex as an appendix to the moving papers a list, by caption, index number and county of pendency, of all Reliance PMV cases in regard to which the applicant thereby seeks to be relieved, and it is further

ORDERED that counsel making the first such application shall obtain an index number and file a request for judicial intervention using the omnibus caption hereinabove set forth and the County Clerk of New York County, upon presentation of a copy of this order and payment of appropriate fees, shall issue an index number to the application under the said caption and the Clerk of the court, upon presentation of a copy of this order, shall assign the application under the said caption as set forth above, and it is further

ORDERED that subsequent omnibus applications for the same relief pursuant to this order shall be brought under the said caption and index number and that no additional request for judicial intervention need be filed, and it is further

ORDERED that, in the event that any such application is granted, outgoing counsel shall file a copy of the court's order in the file of each Reliance PMV case in regard to which counsel has been relieved.
