
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Administrative Judge, I hereby direct the relevant back offices to assign to the Hon. Paul G. Feinman (Part 12) all cases that have been or may in the future be commenced in the Supreme Court, Civil Branch, New York County arising out of a fire alleged to have taken place on or about February 29, 2009 at a building known as 22 James Street, New York, New York ("22 James St. Fire Actions"). Four lawsuits have now been commenced in this court against DMHZ Corp. The first of these, *You Qun Liu v. DMHZ Corp.*, Index Number 104930/2009, was assigned on April 24, 2009 to the Hon. Paul G. Feinman. The second, *Gallo v. DMHZ Corp.*, Index Number 107464/2009, was assigned on August 26, 2009 to the Hon. Paul G. Feinman. The third, *Praetorian Insurance Co. v. DMHZ Corp.*, Index Number 101469/2010, was assigned on February 24, 2010 to the Hon. Marilyn G. Diamond. The fourth, *Anna My Luu v. DMHZ Corp.*, Index Number 118010/2009, was assigned on February 25, 2010 to the Hon. Marilyn G. Diamond. In the interests of efficiency for the parties and the court and judicial economy, Justice Feinman will preside over these and related cases. The Trial Support Office is directed to reassign the last two of the cases listed above to Justice Feinman.

A copy of this Administrative Order shall be attached by the filing attorney to the Request for Judicial Intervention in any 22 James St. Fire Action now pending or hereafter commenced in this court. The filing attorney shall note in the "Related Cases" area of the RJJ that there are cases involving the same or related parties pending in this court.

Counsel are advised that Part 12 is an e-filing Part and that Justice Feinman does not require submission of working copies (i.e., copies in hard copy format) of documents that are e-filed in cases assigned to his Part. Any counsel who does not have an ID and Password for the New York State Courts Electronic Filing System ("NYSCEF") should contact the E-Filing Office (646-386-3610 or newyorkef@courts.state.ny.us). A *User's Manual* and *FAQs* are posted on the NYSCEF website (www.nycourts.gov/efile) explaining how the NYSCEF system functions. Training courses are conducted weekly at this courthouse, with two free CLE credits provided to attending attorneys. Counsel may sign up for training by contacting the Office, the staff of which will also be glad to answer any questions counsel may have.
