Consensual Electronic Filing is Available in Westchester County Surrogate's Court
Effective March 21, 2016 for all newly filed cases.

A consensual e-filing program will be implemented effective March 21, 2016 as follows:

- Probate proceedings
- Administration proceedings
- Voluntary Administration proceedings
- Accounting proceedings
- Miscellaneous proceedings
- Guardianship proceedings
- Miscellaneous filings related to the above proceedings

The New York State Courts Electronic Filing (NYSCEF) system is easy to use. Training will be offered by the staff of the E-Filing Resource Center both on-line and on-site. Participants in the on-site sessions receive two free CLE credit hours. Information regarding training sessions is available on the NYSCEF website at www.nycourts.gov/efile. While many Westchester County attorneys may already be familiar with consensual and mandatory e-filing from their experience in other courts or counties in the Ninth Judicial District, staff in the Westchester County Surrogate's Court will assist the local Bar with guidance throughout the implementation of the program.
