
By letter dated October 10, 2014, counsel for defendant Edward Carp requests that this action be transferred into the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70 (e). To date, no other correspondence has been received.

In this action, plaintiff alleges claims for breach of contract, breach of fiduciary duty, and fraud stemming from his allegations that he is a shareholder of defendant Minify, LLC (Minify). Plaintiff seeks monetary damages, as well as an order: (1) declaring that he owns twenty-five percent of Minify, (2) transferring ownership of certain software technology to Minify, and (3) directing defendants to produce Minify's records and books. Since the action meets the standards for assignment to the Commercial Division in this county (see Uniform Rule 202.70 [a], [b] [1]), the request is granted.

The Trial Support Office is directed to randomly reassign this action from Part 12 (Jaffe, J.) to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
