



## **NOTICE OF eCHECK (ACH)** **ACCEPTANCE & SERVICE FEE**

Commencing September 19, 2023, the Unified Court System will begin accepting eCheck (ACH) payments for Attorney Registration fees paid pursuant to Section 468-a of the NY Judiciary Law and Part 118 of the Rules of the Chief Administrator. The eCheck (ACH) payment option will supplement the credit card and debit card methods presently accepted via the electronic Attorney Online Services system.

**A service fee of \$1.00 will be assessed on all eCheck (ACH) payments, submitted with electronically filed biennial Attorneys Registration fees, to cover the cost of processing these transactions.**

If you file electronically and use the eCheck (ACH) option, there will be two transaction numbers generated, one for the biennial registration fee and one for the service fee.

The Court System is continuing to explore other technologies for electronic payments that minimize processing fees.
