Johnson [Part 11], Justice Mojgan C. Lancman [Part 20], Justice Leonard Livote [Part 33], and Justice Frederick D. R. Sampson [Part 31]. Please note that discovery motions filed before Justice Phillip Hom and Justice Denise N. Johnson will require an appearance at the Long Island City courthouse located at 25-10 Court Square, Long Island City, New York.

Effective **April 17, 2023**, in-person appearances will be required on discovery motions, only, filed before Justice Carmen R. Velasquez [Part 38].

Discovery motions include motions made pursuant to Article 31 of the CPLR, 22 NYCRR §202.7 and 22 NYCRR §202.8. Motions for summary judgment are not included in this category.

A copy of the NYSCEF Confirmation Notice(s) for any document(s) e-filed by a party under the sequence number of the discovery motion <u>must</u> be submitted by that party to the Part Clerk on the return date, or any adjourn date, of the discovery motion.
