

YOU SHOULD NOT ENTER THE COURTHOUSE IF YOU:



- Have been in any of the following countries within the last 14 days: **China, South Korea, Japan, Italy, Iran**, or any other country reported by the Centers for Disease Control (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html>) as having “widespread sustained” or “sustained community” spread of the coronavirus; or
- Reside or have had close contact with anyone who has been in one of the countries listed above within the last 14 days; or
- Have been directed to quarantine, isolate or self-monitor at home for the coronavirus by any doctor, hospital or health agency; or
- Have been diagnosed with, or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with, **COVID-19**; or
- Have flu-like symptoms.

- **If you fit into any of the above categories, YOU SHOULD NOT ENTER THE COURTHOUSE.**
- **Instead, call the number listed below immediately, and report your situation for instructions on how to proceed. (Also, if you are a party in a case and have an attorney, call your attorney immediately and report your situation.)**
- **If you have a scheduled appearance or were otherwise directed to attend court today, you will not be penalized for your absence provided you call this number:**
