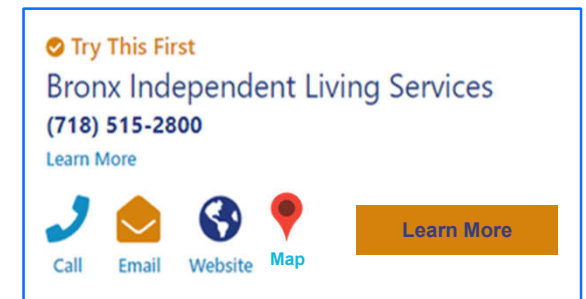
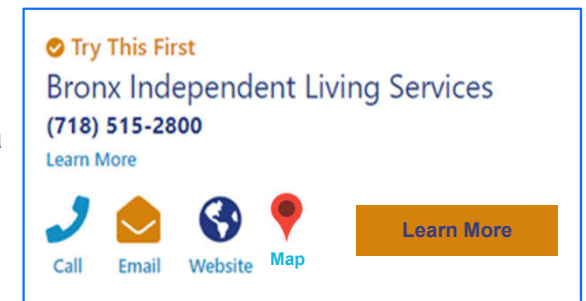
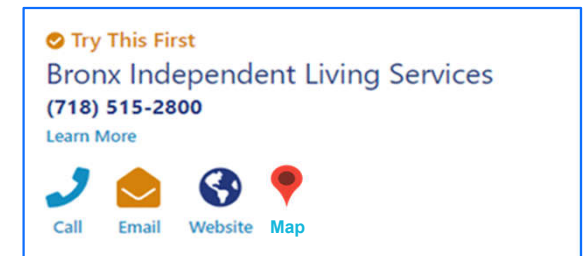
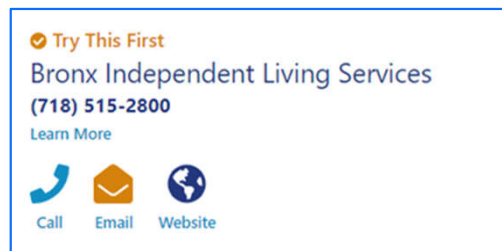
- Ever had an idea for a design improvement but weren't sure how to explain or describe it?
- Google Slides can be used to create simple mockups
- Why is Slides good for mockups?
 - Freeform text/image/shape placement
 - Easy to export slide(s) in many formats
 - Easy collaboration
 - Permissions, commenting
- How to?
 - Use the shapes, image pasting, and text to shape your idea
 - Use Formatting Options
- Example →
 - I want better organization cards

1 - **Add new icons:** Take a screenshot of the current design. Take a map icon off the web, add in a text box "map"

2 - **Button making:** Create a rectangle shape, add text. You have a button!

3 - **Hover over:** Use drop shadow over the card to show a hover over styling

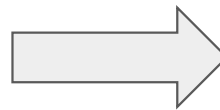



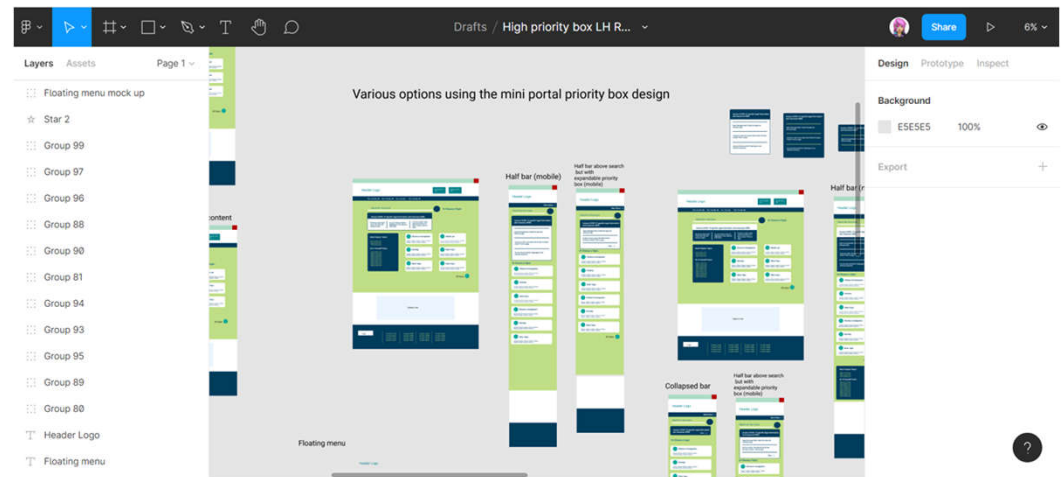

Figma - Mockup and prototype collaboration

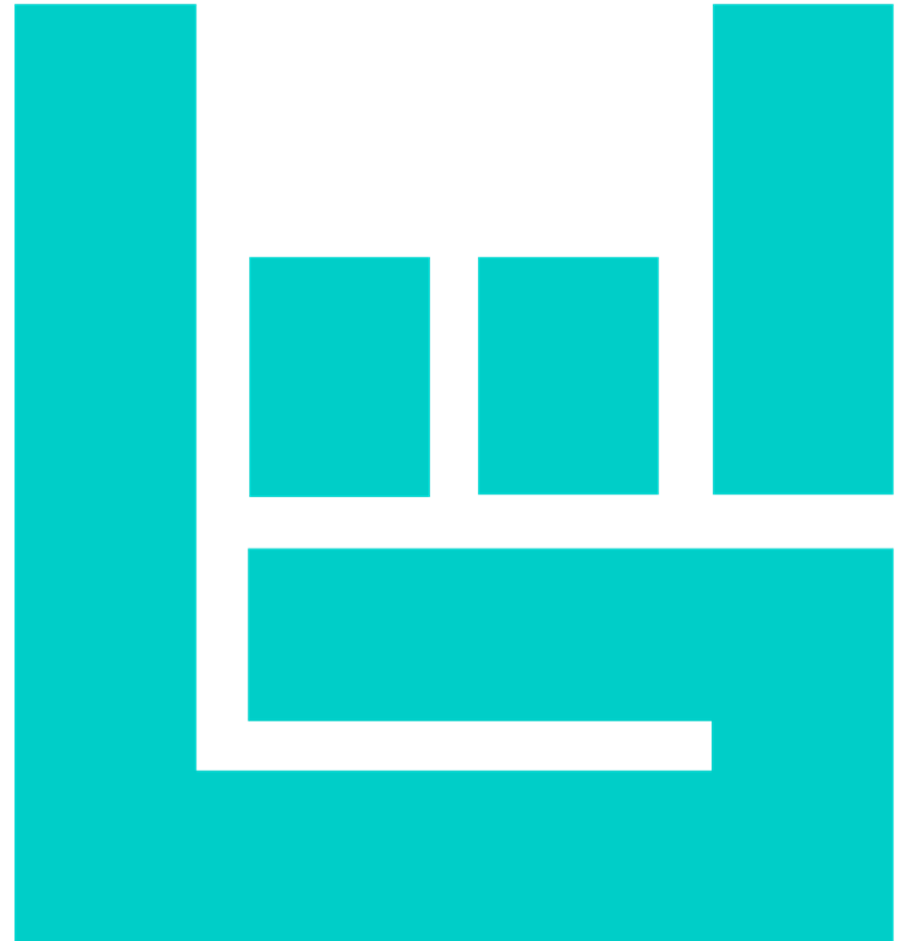
- Need a *real* prototype tool?

- Moderately difficult to learn but commenting and review is easier to learn
- Useful for all sorts of things
 - Design review and commenting
 - Mockups
 - Logo generation
 - Image recoloring
 - Actual prototyping including prototype UI



WebAIM Contrast - WCAG color contrast



- Color contrast standards are important to adhere to so everyone can read your site, images, etc
- [WebAIM offers a free contrast checker tool](#)
- Simply enter the hex codes of your colors and it will tell you how it measures up to WCAG 2.0 guidelines
- You can use the sliders to alter the colors to meet the standard and then copy out the resulting hex codes



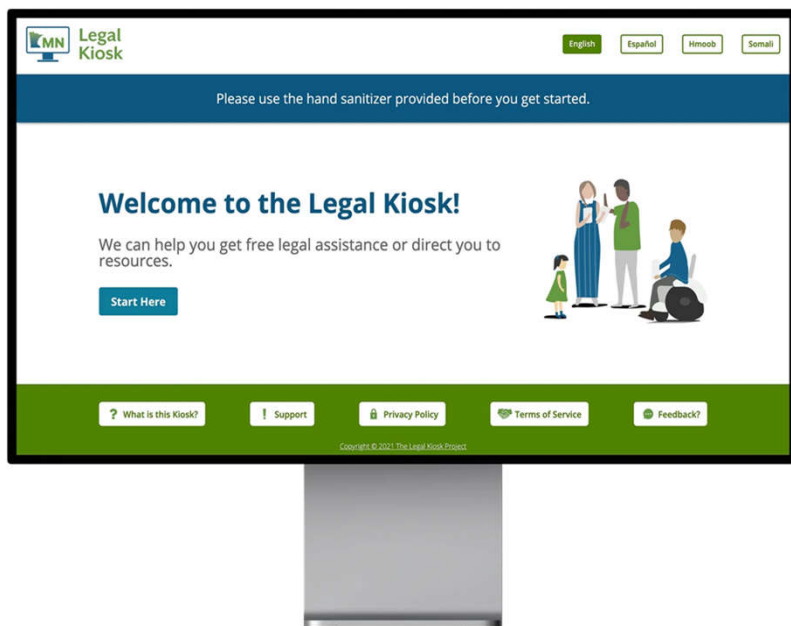

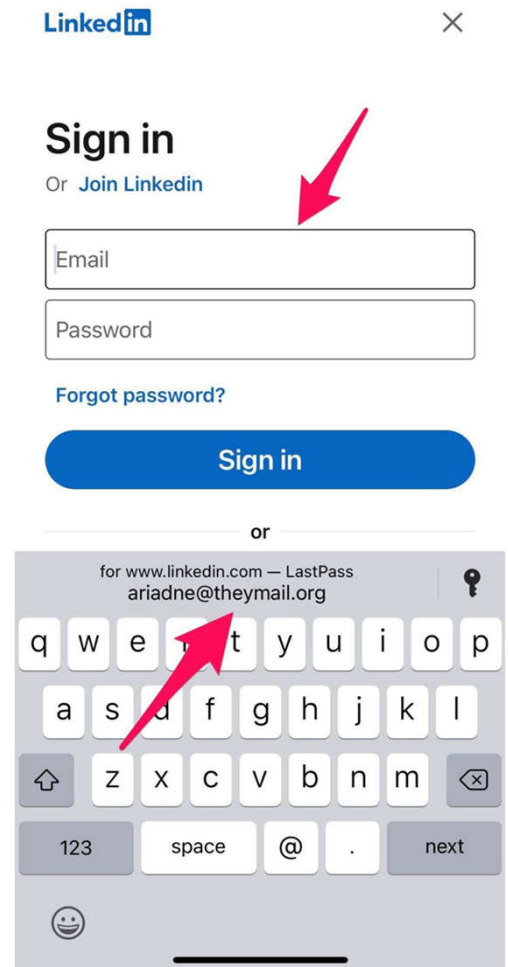
Features in Google Calendar

LastPass- Password security

- Do you have a password manager?
- For the keys to your home, your car, your bike lock, your office, your anything: Would you use the same key for all of them?
 - Nope! How dangerous! So don't make the same mistake with your web passwords.
- Web security is crucial these days and you need strong passwords
- When logging in on mobile, a password link will appear above your keyboard, you can tap it to fill the form or to select any password within your "vault"
- LastPass offers strong password security with browser and mobile integrations
- Use a passphrase as your master password!
 - Passphrases are easier to remember and are still strong
 - Example: TimIsTheBestCoworkerAroundTown!
- Free version is okay but paid is best

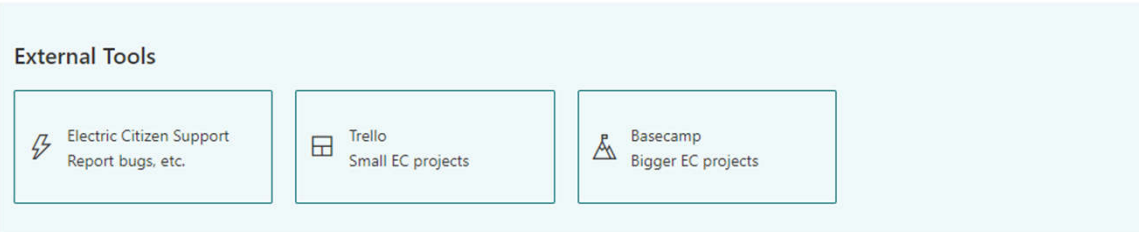
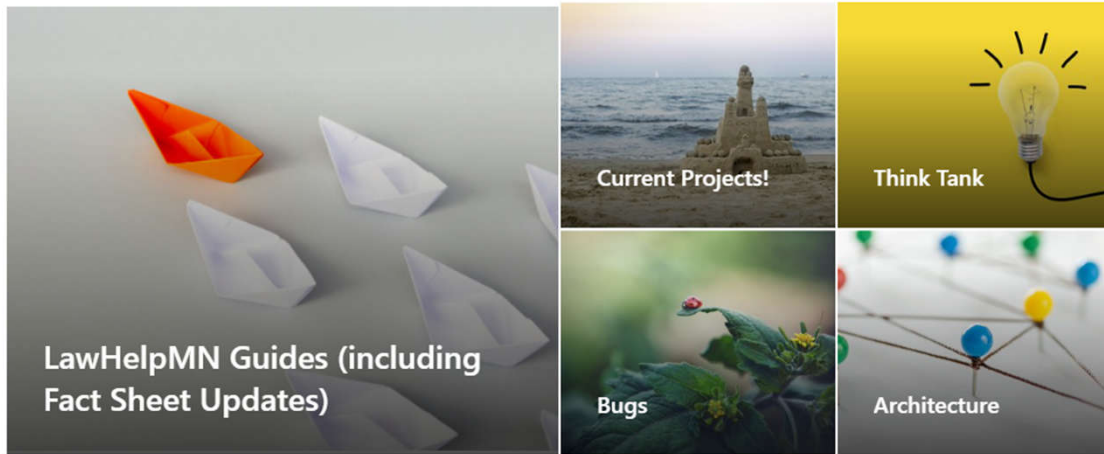
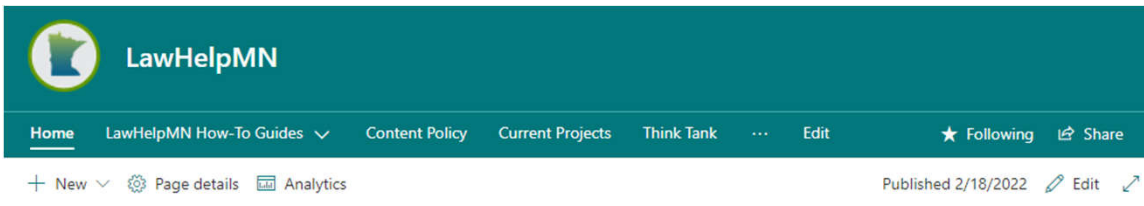

SharePoint Sites

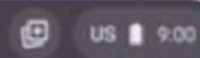
- Create an internal website to keep everyone on the same page

- Frequently used links in one place



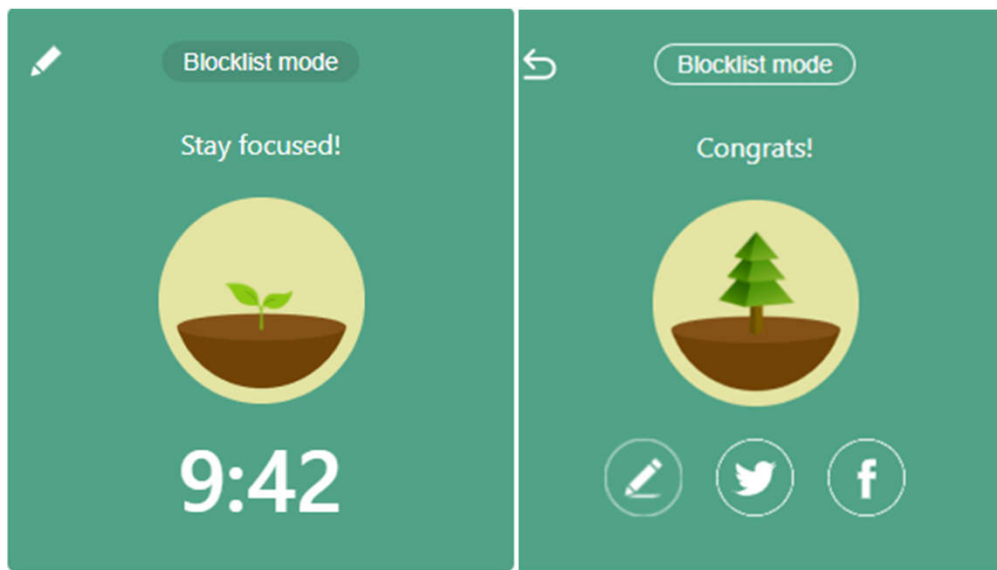

- You can even customize the image of the drink!

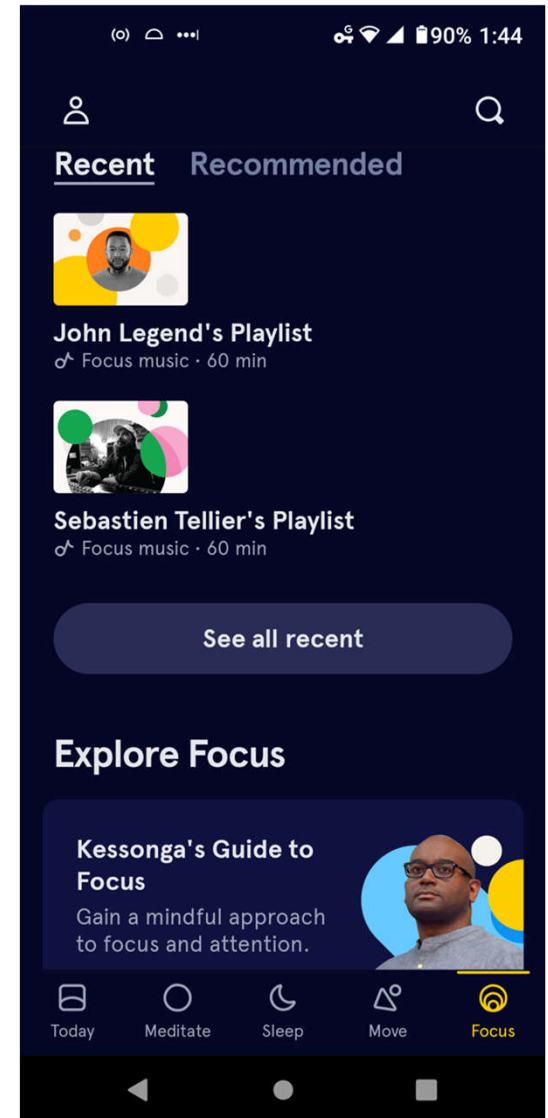


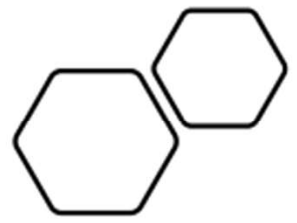


- ★ Visual & tactical collaboration
