Family Court Pilot Program

VEC – Virtual Evidence Courtroom

For Courts Not Currently Authorized for E-Filing

VEC II – Virtual Evidence Courtroom II – Web based application outside of NYSCEF

Expansion of EDDS to include the option to submit commencement documents in all City Courts located in the 8th JD

EDDS: Commencement Documents in the 8th Judicial District

<u>AO/253/22</u>

Successful pilot program in Buffalo City Court.

Commencement documents accepted through EDDS in all City Courts the 8th Judicial District.

The applicable filing fees shall be paid on-line by credit card through the EDDS application.

Commencement documents are deemed as "filed" upon the payment of any required fee and notice from the court clerk that the document has been received and accepted for filing.

Virtual Evidence Courtroom 2 (VEC II)

Stand-alone program that is available for use in courts NOT AUTHORIZED for NYSCEF

Attorneys may use their Attorney Online Services account to log into VEC2

E-mail automatically sent to parties once hearing is created with instructions to access VEC2 and, for non-attorneys, how to create an account

Court may ADMIT, MARK FOR ID, RETURN, and PURGE evidence

Many different formats accepted including video, audio, and Word

Pilot program in Court of Claims beginning this quarter

Virtual Evidence Court Room (VEC)

- Available to all Supreme Court Justices
- Not a part of the NYSCEF record
- Versatile tool to aid virtual or in-person hearings and trials
- May be accessed only by Participating Parties and the Court
- Participating Parties are notified via e-mail of the VEC being created, including instructions on how to use the program
- Court has options to ADMIT, MARK FOR ID, RETURN, or PURGE submitted evidence
- Must be in PDF/A Format -future expansion to other file types such as video, audio, word files, and other formats.
