## THE OFFICE OF THE MANAGING INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR FIDUCIARY APPOINTMENTS

is within the Office of the Inspector General and is responsible for maintaining and enforcing the rules governing appointments by the court in certain types of litigation. The Office also conducts confidential investigations regarding fiduciary appointments (court appointments in guardianship, foreclosure, receivership, surrogate, and matrimonial matters).



## WHO CAN FILE A COMPLAINT?

Judicial and non-judicial employees of the Unified Court System, court users and members of the public can file a complaint regarding an appointee's unsatisfactory performance or conduct which is incompatible with the appointment.
