Request for Proposals #070 Family Treatment Court Evaluation Services Rockland County, New York

- 1. Will the successful bidder have a project manager from court staff assigned to work with them?
- A. Yes, the Rockland County Family Treatment Court team will work with the successful bidder.
- 2. What is the estimated volume of treatment participants for this RFP during the grant period?
- A. The number of families to be served is estimated at 15-20 per year.
- 3. Will court staff handle all data entry into the database created by the successful bidder?
- A. No. The successful bidder will be expected to enter data into the database.
- 4. How will the successful bidder access the data from the database to ensure all necessary data is collected and for analysis?
- A. The successful bidder can request a download of the data that is entered into the court database.
- 5. Can the awarded grantee attend a few of the court dates and proceedings for those individuals being considered for the treatment programs?
- A. Yes. The successful bidder should attend court sessions to get a better understanding of how the project operates.
- 6. Will similar data be collected in the database for the individuals who decide not to attend the treatment programs?
- A. No, at this time data is not being collected for those not entering the Family Treatment Court.
- 7. Per Section D on page 8 of the RFP, "Applicants must submit a line item budget proposal indicating the total amount of funding requested for each period, and the budget proposal must also include a total proposed budget for the entire contract term (February 14, 2020 September 30, 2022). However, the required budget form does not have space for multi-year budget. Would the County confirm if the Bidder should prepare three separate budgets (i.e., one budget per year, as well as a total budget for all three years)?
- A. Applicants are to complete the required budget form for each requested budget period, including once for the entire contract term (February 14, 2020 September 30, 2022) and submit this together with their proposal. The budget for the entire contract term must equal the sum of the budgets for the periods within the term.
- 8. Would the County please clarify if the awardees will be deemed a subrecipient or a subcontractor? If a subcontractor, please confirm which contract type the County expects to issue (e.g., fixed price, cost reimbursement, etc.).
- A. This RFP is not issued by Rockland County, but by the New York State Unified Court System (UCS). The successful bidder will be considered a contractor and not a sub-

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recipient. Payment is generally made within thirty (30) days of the expiration of each quarter of each Budget Period upon submission by Contractor to UCS of a reconciliation report in a format prescribed by or acceptable to UCS.

- 9. Would the County please confirm if the source of funding for this project is the federal government?
- A. The funding source is a U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) grant (2019-DC-BX-0103) to the New York State Unified Court System.
- 10. Does the Government have a preferred font type for the proposal submission (e.g., Arial, Times New Roman, etc.)?
- A. No.
