SUBJECT: Language-Specific Monitoring of Per Diem Interpreter Costs

Attached is an amended schedule of the Departmental Accumulator Codes to be used in all jurisdictions of the Unified Court System whenever payment is made for per diem interpreter services. The entry of an appropriate accumulator code on vouchers for per diem interpreter services is designed to assist court managers in the identification of interpreter usage patterns which may be material to court operations, planning, and resource management.

Special accumulator reports may be printed by district/administrative staff who have authorized access to the UCS mainframe 'ADMN' administrative services applications (see Volume 2, Part X of the Financial Planning & Control Manual). However, these reports are only as useful as the level of consistency and accuracy with which the voucher 'Dept. Accum' field is completed. Please ensure that all personnel within your respective jurisdictions who are responsible for the processing of vouchers, particularly those representing payment for per diem interpreter services, are aware of this reporting requirement.

Should you encounter any additional languages/dialects that are not included herein which you believe warrant the establishment of a new accumulator code, please contact the UCS Division of Personnel for verification. Accumulator codes will be established by the Division of Budget & Finance on an as needed basis.
