SUBJECT: Vehicle and Traffic Law section 1809-a (2)(b) - Parking Surcharges

* This bulletin effectively amends provisions for the <u>disposition</u> of parking violation surcharges in cities where the population is at least 100,000 but less than 1,000,000.

Chapter 57 of the Laws of 2007 amends section 1809-a (2)(b) of the Vehicle and Traffic Law to provide that, effective January 1, 2008, in cities with a population of at least 100,000 but less than 1,000,000, mandatory parking surcharges collected pursuant to this section are to be transmitted to the appropriate local government to be used for its criminal justice programs.

Parking surcharges collected by a city with a population in excess of 1,000,000 should continue to be reported as state revenue utilizing revenue object code 35355.
