SUBJECT: Judicial Travel Reimbursement - Attendance at Judicial Association Meetings

* This supersedes Budget Bulletin number 1002, issued January 22, 2010.

This bulletin amends the UCS Financial Planning & Control Manual relative to judicial travel reimbursement in connection with attendance at judicial association meetings, effective October 1, 2012:

<u>Multi-bench</u> judges or justices will be reimbursed for a maximum of four days' and four nights' lodging and meal expenses related to attendance at judicial association meetings. The four-day maximum may be used for one or more meetings per calendar year. <u>All other judges and justices</u> will be eligible for reimbursement for a maximum of three days' and three nights' lodging, and meal expenses related to attendance at judicial association meetings. The three day maximum may be used for one or more meetings needings.

Reimbursement will be made for eligible transportation expenses for each judicial association meeting attended, not to exceed three meetings per calendar year.
