## PRELIMINARY CONFERENCE PROCEDURE

Commencing July 13, 2020, preliminary conferences in the Differentiated Case Management Part ("DCM") will be conducted virtually. Prior to the scheduled conference date, counsel shall confer and complete a proposed Preliminary Conference Stipulation and Order, which is available on the Court's website. Counsel shall upload a proposed Preliminary Conference Stipulation and Order to NYSCEF no less than one business day prior to the scheduled conference. If the parties cannot agree on the terms of a proposed Preliminary Conference Stipulation and Order, on the morning of the scheduled conference they must contact DCM at (631) 852-2894 to request a telephone conference with a Court Attorney-Referee.

Please be advised that prior to being calendared for a preliminary conference, all cases will be evaluated by a Court Attorney-Referee for referral to the Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") Part for an early settlement conference. If a case is referred to the ADR Part, an ADR Referral Order will be issued and a preliminary conference will not be scheduled.
